

Recommended Materials for Hinging and Matting Works on Paper

Adhesives on Object:

Zen Shofu wheat starch paste (needs to be cooked)

Talas Wheat Paste No. 301 (pre-cooked instant paste, mix with water)

Hinges:

Japanese paper hinges – full sheets available in different weights

Lineco water soluble adhesive hinging tapes – Paper Hinging Tape/Linen Hinging Tape (for attachment to mat/attaching mat boards together)

Matboards:

Bainbridge Alpharag® Artcare™ matboards (100% cotton rag, acid and lignin free)

Crescent RagMat® Museum Solids matboards (100% cotton rag, acid and lignin free)

Glazing:

Acrylite® OP-3 or Plexiglas® UF 5 (UV-filtered acrylic glazing)

Tru-Vue Conservation Clear® (UV-filtered glass glazing)

Vapor barrier:

Coroplast® Archival grade (corrugated polypropylene backing board)

Polyester sheet film – brands: Mylar/Melinex/Hostaphan (requires additional backing board)

Backing board:

Archival quality corrugated board – suppliers: Gaylord, Talas, Hollinger, Archivart (acid and lignin free)


Dust cover:

Archival quality paper from roll – suppliers: Gaylord, Talas, Hollinger, Archivart (acid and lignin free) Tape for sealing mat packages/attaching dustcovers:

3M™ Polyester Film Tape 850 – for sealing mat packages

3M™ #415 Double Sided Tape – for attaching dustcovers/polyester film

3M™ ATG Tape – for attaching dustcovers, use with tape gun applicator
