

The goal of the **Connecting to Collections Care Webinar Committee** is to develop online programming for the staff and volunteers of small- to mid-sized cultural institutions.

The Webinar Committee:

- Determines webinar topics, presenters, and schedules and advises on instructional content.
- Reviews webinar evaluations to determine course topics and program improvements.
- Assists in disseminating program announcements to allied organizations and liaisons.

The Webinar Committee accomplishes these tasks by working with the C2C Care Online Community Committee; key groups within the American Institute for Conservation (Collections Care Network, Education and Training Committee, Emerging Conservation Professionals Network, Conservation Assessment for Preservation (CAP) Program); and national and regional organizations for cultural institutions. The Committee is appointed by and reports to the C2C Care Leadership Committee. The committee provides guidance to staff of the Foundation of the American Institute for Conservation (FAIC) and works within funding requirements of the Institute for Museum and Library Services (IMLS).
